SCENE 1

LIGHTS UP - A BLACK STAGE SPRINKLED WITH STARS

IN THE CENTER OF THE STAGE SITS THE SUN, THE ONLY SOURCE OF LIGHT. AROUND THE SUN, ON NESTED TURNTABLES ARE PEOPLE REPRESENTING THE NINE PLANETS, AND A BEVY OF CHILDREN SERVING AS THE ASTEROID BELT. THE TURNTABLES ROTATE EVERYTHING AROUND THE SUN AT THE APPROPRIATE(ISH) SPEED.

EARTH: But no, it's actually kind of cool. They are sort of like pets, I guess? And they are EVERYWHERE, it turns out. I really only just noticed a little while ago.

VENUS: I dunno... sounds kinda creepy. They're crawling all over you?

EARTH: Yup! I've named them dinosaurs.

VENUS: Whatever floats your clouds, I guess.

EARTH AND VENUS BOTH START TO ROUND BEHIND THE SUN AS MARS AND JUPITER COME INTO VIEW.

MARS: Come onnnnnn, please??

JUPITER: Dude, seriously. I don't feel like playing right now.

MARS: You are such a spoilsport.

JUPITER: FINE.

JUPITER REACHES OUT AND PUSHES ONE OF THE CHILDREN/ASTEROIDS. IT MAKES A LONG RUNNING ARC, AND JUMPS INTO MARS' ARMS GIGGLING.

ASTEROID: WHEEEEEEEEE!!

MARS: YAY!!!!!!

MARS, JUPITER AND ASTEROID ROUND BEHIND THE  
SUN AS EARTH, VENUS AND MERCURY REAPPEAR.

EARTH: Sure, it was kinda weird at first, but they're  
adorable. I think I'm going to keep them. Watching  
them run and play and occasionally eat each other is  
delightful.

MERCURY: (speeding past) GROSS!

VENUS: I agree. You really should reconsider your enthusiasm  
for these parasites.

EARTH: If you had your own, you'd know...

VENUS: Nope. Nope. No thank you. Nope! Ain't gonna happen.

EARTH: Some of them can fly.

MERCURY: (speeding past) WHAT?!?!

VENUS: Don't get too close to me, I don't want them flying  
over here.

EARTH: They can't fly THAT high. They are definitely stuck  
here. Super not contagious.

VENUS: Somehow I don't believe you...

THEY ARC BACK AROUND BEHIND THE SUN. BY  
THIS POINT, MARS AND JUPITER HAVE RETURNED.

MARS: More! More!!

JUPITER: Why are you so needy?!?

MARS: MOREEEEEEE!

A COMET ENTERS AND COMES STREAKING BY. IT  
GETS CLOSE TO JUPITER, WHO PUSHES IT  
TOWARDS MARS.

JUPITER: Here, play with this.

THE COMET RUNS AND JUMPS INTO MARS' ARMS,  
AND PLACES A WHITE TOQUE ON ITS HEAD.

MARS: Ooooh! Ice hat! Very fashionable.

JUPITER AND MARS ARC AROUND BEHIND THE SUN  
AS EARTH AND VENUS EMERGE. MERCURY SCOOTs  
PAST RELATIVELY FREQUENTLY.

VENUS: Okay, I guess I could see the appeal from an  
entertainment perspective.

EARTH: Right?! It's thousands of years of fun all wrapped up  
in scaly little beasts that roar and kill each other.

VENUS: (shaking her head) Aren't there friendly ones?

EARTH: Some just eat my grass.

VENUS: I thought you looked like you had a trim. Nice!

THEY ROTATE OUT, AND MARS AND JUPITER  
RETURN.

MARS: AGAINNNNNNN!

JUPITER: Fine. Last one, though. After this, you have to leave  
me alone.

JUPITER REACHES OUT AND PUSHES A RATHER  
LARGE CHILD OUT OF THE ASTEROID BELT. IT  
ARCS AWAY AND BENDS BACK TOWARDS MARS,  
SLOWLY PICKING UP SPEED. IT BEGINS TO RUN,  
BUT INSTEAD OF RUNNING AND JUMPING INTO  
MARS' ARMS, IT GRABS AHOLD OF THEM AND  
SWINGS AROUND, LETTING GO INTO ANOTHER ARC  
THAT SWINGS IT AROUND BEHIND THE SUN AHEAD  
OF THE OTHER TWO.

JUPITER: You missed!

MARS: No! No fair!

JUPITER: Existence isn't fair, princess.

MARS: AWWWW!

MARS BEGINS TO CRY AS THEY FOLLOW THE  
ASTEROID BEHIND THE SUN. EARTH AND VENUS  
RE-EMERGE.

VENUS: Okay, you sold me. They're actually pretty cool. And  
yeah, maybe I am a little jealous. But I can just  
watch from here...

EARTH: I have never been this happy...

AS THEY SPEAK, THE ASTEROID HAS RE-EMERGED  
AS WELL, AND RUNS FULL SPEED IN AN ARC THAT  
TAKES IT DIRECTLY TOWARDS EARTH. AS EARTH  
SAYS "HAPPY" THE ASTEROID JUMPS, LANDING ON  
EARTH'S BACK. THEY BOTH TUMBLE, AND EARTH  
SPILLS DOZENS OF TINY PLASTIC DINOSAURS  
ONTO THE FLOOR. EARTH SHOUTS AS THEY MOVE  
BACK BEHIND THE SUN.

EARTH: Noooooooooooooooooooo!

MARS AND JUPITER RE-EMERGE.

JUPITER: What was that?

MARS: Dunno.

EARTH AND VENUS RE-EMERGE. EARTH IS ON ITS  
KNEES SOBBING AT THE PLASTIC DINOSAURS  
SPILLED EVERYWHERE.
